The Covid-19 Pandemic was an Information War against Citizens of the World

Some experts had predicted that the Third World War will be an <u>information warfare</u> and the battlefields will be the internet. The Covid-19 pandemic played out perfectly as predicted. Almost all mainstream social media platforms, information outlets and consequently world governments were hijacked by Big Pharma. The <u>Facebook Files</u> a set of internal documents, <u>released</u> under compulsion on demand by the US House of Representative, reveal the strange censorship policies pursued by it. All posts questioning mandates, or doubts about getting the vaccine, and criticizing government policy were censored. While the internal document did not consider them misinformation they were blocked as they created a "vaccine-negative" environment. Any post on vaccine injury was silenced. Major media continued the propaganda that the vaccines were safe and effective – which was untrue. But users continued to believe, their mind was captured by feeding selective information. Wikipedia too resorted to cherry picking information. Even the inventor of Wikipedia, Larry Sanger, did <u>not</u> <u>trust</u> it anymore!

The trend continues. The extent of damage and death caused by the vaccine is left to independent researchers who are working from a tsunami of anecdotes and hard-to-find data. To make matters more difficult, there's a concerted effort to cover it all up.

How can we explain this? The regulatory agencies get half or more of their own funding from pharmaceutical companies. Media broadcasted the propaganda because three-quarters or more of their advertising revenue came from pharma. The development of the shots themselves benefitted from enormous government grants.

The common citizen is on an uneven virtual battlefield in a war which is going to last long.

Oncologists call for restriction in use of pesticides and promote organic farming: Can it work?

Nearly 100 oncologists practicing across the country gathered in Shimla for a two-day conference and discussed the increasing number of cancer patients in the state.

Lung cancer among males in Himachal Pradesh is increasing. The head and professor of Shimla Cancer Hospital at Indira Gandhi Medical College, Dr Manish Gupta said that the use of pesticides is a serious concern as they are getting into groundwater.

"Cancer is considered a lifestyle disease; lifestyle is going from bad to worse. Our people are not doing exercises, using more mobile and other technologies. The number of patients is increasing each year, with 6000 new patients of cancer each year in Himachal Pradesh. We are getting everything including floor, fruits and vegetables not in original form. People are using pesticides." Dr Gupta said.

The delegates at the conference suggested restriction on use of pesticides and are <u>demanding</u> shift towards organic farming.

UHO would recommend more research on the causes of rise in cancer in the state. Pesticides are only one of the various causes of cancer. What about tobacco use? Many in hilly cold areas like Himachal Pradesh, use fossil fuels which can lead to indoor air pollution. Can this be one of the factors? How feasible and sustainable will be organic farming on a mass scale? We require interdisciplinary research on these issues involving oncologists, agriculture scientists, and other experts.
